- 3. The application must include two brief letters of recommendation from your community life (a pastor, an employer), and one from your academic life, a teacher, etc.
- 4. A brief essay on "What a Post-Secondary Education Means to YOU".
- 5. The application must be turned in at the student's respective high school counseling office by April 15.

Complete the attached application form and send it with the other requested documents to the high school counselor of your school before the specified due date. Applications will be graded on neatness, completion of application, academics, community and school involvement, financial need and your answer to the essay

DISBURSEMENT

Upon receipt of the recipients' college registration the money will be awarded in two equal amounts at the beginning of the Fall and Spring semesters.
